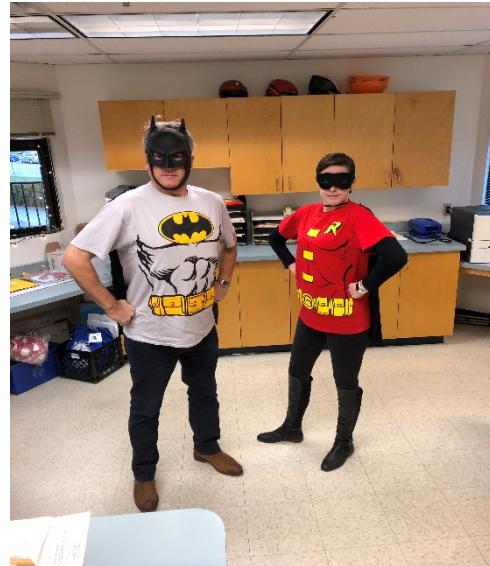


Our Northridge values: Safety, Kindness and Respect
