School Goals: Every year Northridge Elementary sets School Goals to help guide our learning. Our focus for the start of the year is the Salmon. The Salmon teaches us never to give up, even when things are hard. This is a great connection to Terry Fox and the perseverance he showed in his Marathon of Hope. After our Terry Fox run on Friday, each student received a salmon sticker for their perseverance as well.

At our monthly assemblies, students will receive certificates from their teachers for demonstrating the gifts that these animals show. Our next monthly assembly will be on October 26th at 10:30. If your child is being recognized, your child's teacher will let you know so you have the opportunity to attend.

We will continue to let you know how we are learning more about these animals as a school and in classes including through student self reflection and writing activities.
